

# Strategy for increasing coordination of programs/services within a fragmented early childhood system

- Is a system coordination effort, similar to program and eligibility alignment, coordination of funding, and building integrated data systems.
- Requires partnership across programs/services, with levels of collaboration ranging from communication, cooperation, coordination, collaboration, to integration.
- Can partner on a range of enrollment activities, from joint recruitment only to fully coordinated enrollment.
